The value of **PUBLIC PROCUREMENT** in Sweden








The Government's national procurement strategy

Innovation procurement

- Innovation procurement is not a specific method or procurement procedure
- It is rather a formalised way of promoting development in and through public procurement
- Innovation procurement can use a broad range of methods and procedures

- The networks are working on the development of new solutions and procurement preparations






