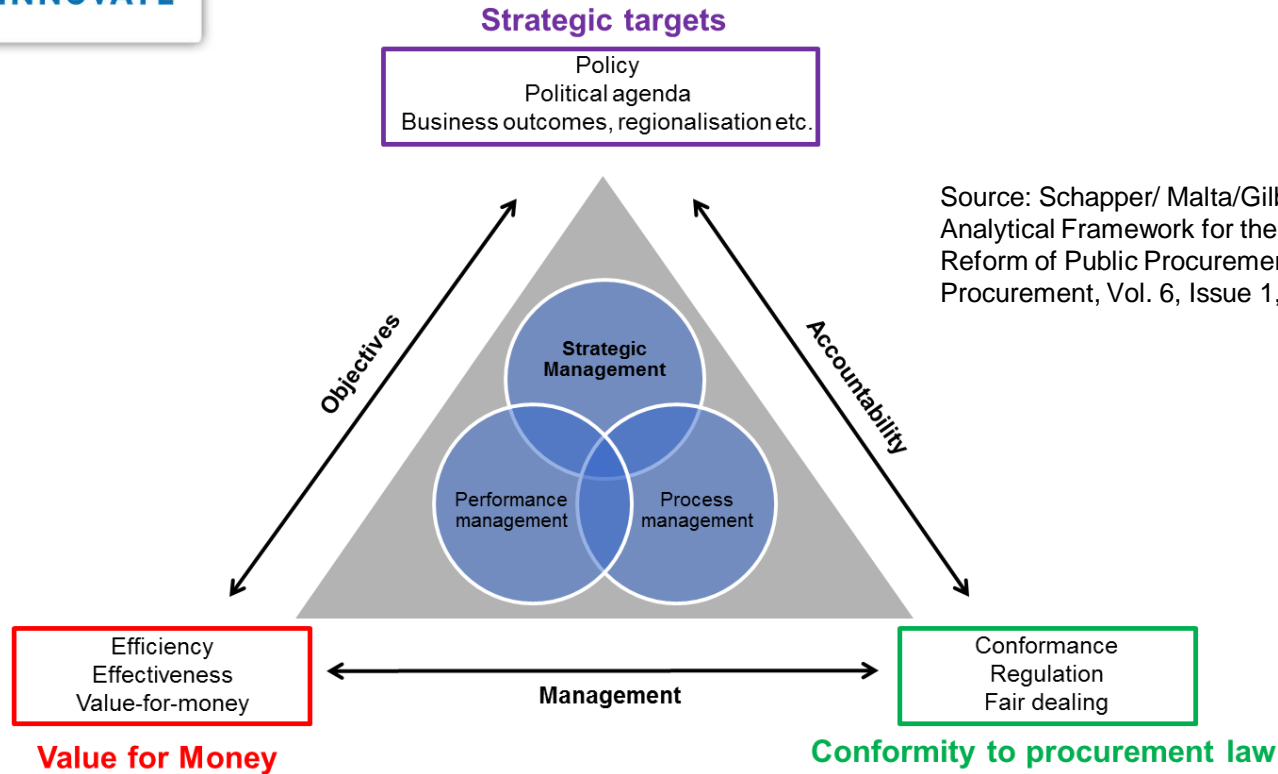

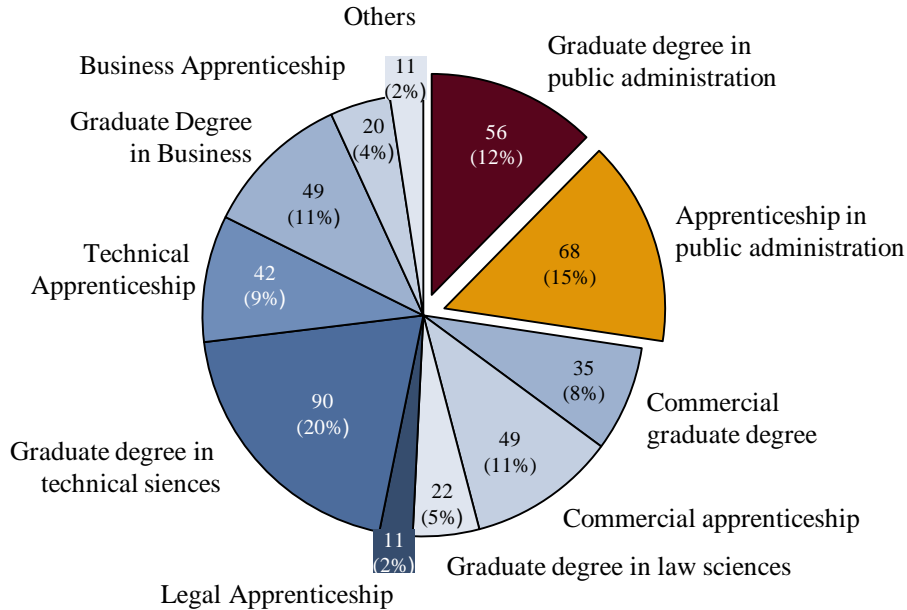

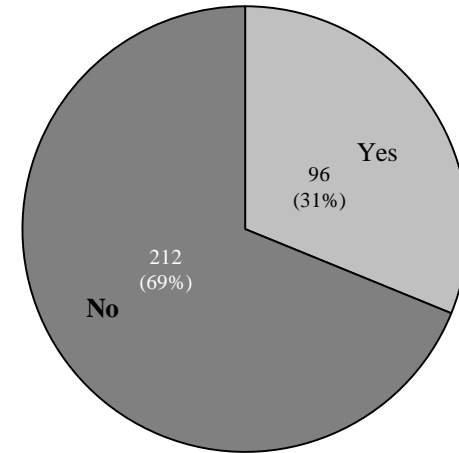

(453 responses, multiple responses possible)

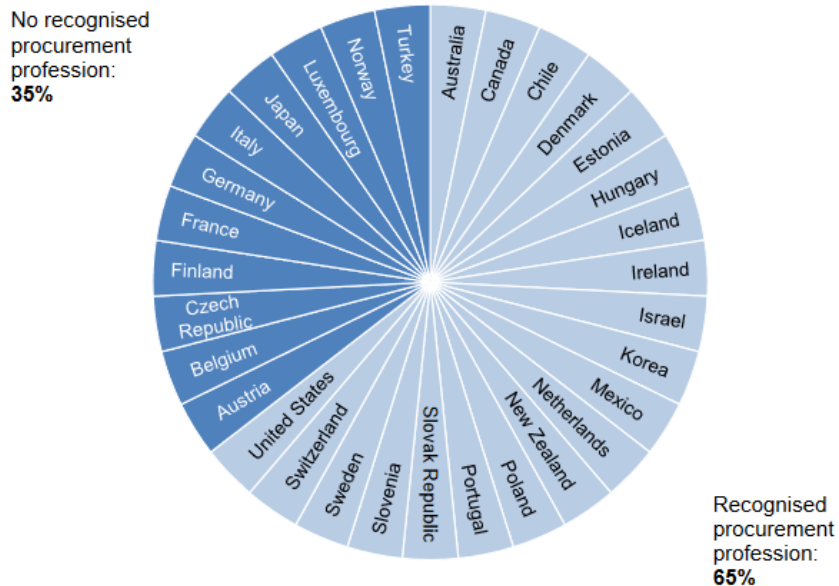


Are the employees working in procurement explicitly trained to cover this function in your institution? (308 responses)

- In 2011 launch of innovation procurement on federal and regional level in Germany by ZENIT
- In 2012 start of EU Contact Point for innovation procurement in North-Rhine Westphalia (NRW) at ZENIT
- In 2013 the German Federal Government for Economic Affairs and Energy (BMWi) launched the Competence Centre for Innovation Procurement (KOINNO)
- Since 01.01.2017 ZENIT is part of KOINNO as EU Contact Point for Public Procurement of Innovation

- Satellite / EGNSS applications for public authorities' pilot: 3 M€ (SPACE-EGNSS-5-2020) – 05.03.2020
- Boosting the effectiveness of the Security Union: 24 M€ (SU-GM02-2018-2020) – 27.08.2020
- Integrated care solutions: 25 M€ (SC1-BHC-20A-2020) – 07.04.2020 (Budget gilt für 20A + 20B (PPI) together*)
- Research Infrastructures/ Innovation pilots: 30 M€ (INFRAINNOV-04-2020) – 17.03.2020 (PCP is part of a RIA)
