FORMAT

METHODOLOGY FOR PARALLEL SESSIONS

- **Presentation:** 5 min. (max.) – each CoLAB should prepare about 4 slides, including:
 - i) Key competences, new technology developments, main customers, and target markets.
 - ii) Status of installation updated to 31st October 2021, with data about the diversification of funding sources and the impact in jobs creation (direct and indirect qualified employment).
 - iii) Challenges and opportunities for the upcoming: 6 months; 2 years; and 5 years.
 - iv) Positioning at national and European level (Resilience and Recovery Plan, Horizon Europe, integration in international networks and platforms, among others).
- **Discussion:** about 30 min.
